A budget is a tool that helps you track and manage your money

Why is having a budget important?

- Gain better control over your money
- Feel less stressed about your money and prevents from going into unnecessary debt
- Make smarter choices about how you are spending your money and what you are spending it on







How to create a budget:

- Write out all sources of income
 (money in) and expenses (money out)
 to reduce your risk of overspending
- Identify the essentials (i.e. rent, groceries, tuition etc.) to allow you to spend smarter and place your budget accordingly
- Evaluate monthly list items and update expenses regularly to better understand your cash flow







Spend smarter:

- Use your student card for discounts
- Use savings apps and coupons
- Take advantages of discounts and special offers
- Buy second-hand
