33 Service Battalion is a Combat Service and Support unit in the Canadian Army Reserve, as part of the 33 Canadian Brigade Group and has 3 locations in Ottawa, North Bay and Sault Ste. Marie. Members of the Army Reserve are citizens who are paid to take military training on a part-time basis to assist the Regular Force in meeting Canada's military commitments.

In addition to their part-time work members of the Army Reserve can take full-time courses during the summer months, or can apply for fulltime positions once they have received sufficient training. Members can also apply for certain postings with Regular Force Units.

The Canadian Army Reserve has many opportunities in a variety of trades. Training is offered on a part-time basis with training on evenings and weekends to work with people who are students and full time employees.

Application Process:

- 1. Submit Application Form to Recruiter;
- Receive entire application package via email;
- Canadian Forces Aptitude Test (CFAT);
- 4. Non-Prescription Drug Screening;
- 5. Physical Fitness Evaluation (FORCE);
- 6. Medical Evaluation;
- 7. Background/Reference Check;
- 8. Interview with Recruiting Officer; and
- 9. Enrolment.

Eligibility Requirements

- Be a Canadian Citizen;
- 18 years old, or 16 with Parental Consent;
- o 15 high school credits; and,
- No outstanding legal obligations.

Trades Description

Mobile Support Equipment Operator

(MSE Op) operates military vehicles ranging in size from standard automobiles to snow removal equipment and all-terrain vehicles in support of the mobility of the Canadian Armed Forces. Qualifications received are transferable to your civilian license.

Weapons Technician works as a member of a maintenance organization located in base or field locations and is employed in the repair and maintenance of all army weapons.

Vehicle Technician belongs to the Electrical and Mechanical Engineering Branch of the Canadian Forces. Each Vehicle Technician is a member of a team responsible for maintaining, repairing and overhauling CAF land vehicles and related equipment to keep them in top condition.

Cook in the Reserve prepares a variety of nutritious food for military personnel, and on occasion, civilians. The meals they make vary from meals prepared in a trailer in the field, to formal multi-course dinners for military and civilian dignitaries.

Human Resource Administrators provide administrative and general human resources support to all military activities.

Financial Services Administrators provide financial assistance and budget resources support to all military activities.

Supply Technicians are responsible for ensuring that all of the supplies and services necessary for Canadian Armed Forces operations are available when and where they are required. They handle a variety of items such as food, fuel, heavy machinery, spare parts, stationery and clothing. Their tasks involve purchasing, warehousing, shipping, receiving, stock control and disposal of obsolete stock and equipment.
