



Health Plan Policy

Purpose

The Nipissing University Student Union (hereinafter “NUSU”) collects \$225 from students in ancillary fees for a health and dental plan. If all requirements are met, students have the option to opt-out of the plan. This policy formalizes the proper guidelines for opting out of the health and dental plan fee.

Coverage Period

Students who remain a part of the health plan will be covered from:

September Start Students: September 1st – August 31st

January Start Students: January 1st – August 31st

The health plan fee will be \$225 regardless of whether the student starts in September or January.

Opting Out

Upon providing proof of alternative coverage and following the appropriate steps, students may opt-out of the health plan and receive a full refund only if completed before the deadline date. No student shall receive reimbursement beyond their opt-out window.

Complaints Procedure

NUSU will forward the student to the ACL website “WeSpeakStudent.com” for any concerns that are specific to an individual student. Should multiple students have concerns about coverage or are experiencing the same problem, a NUSU staff member may reach out to a project manager to seek a solution.
